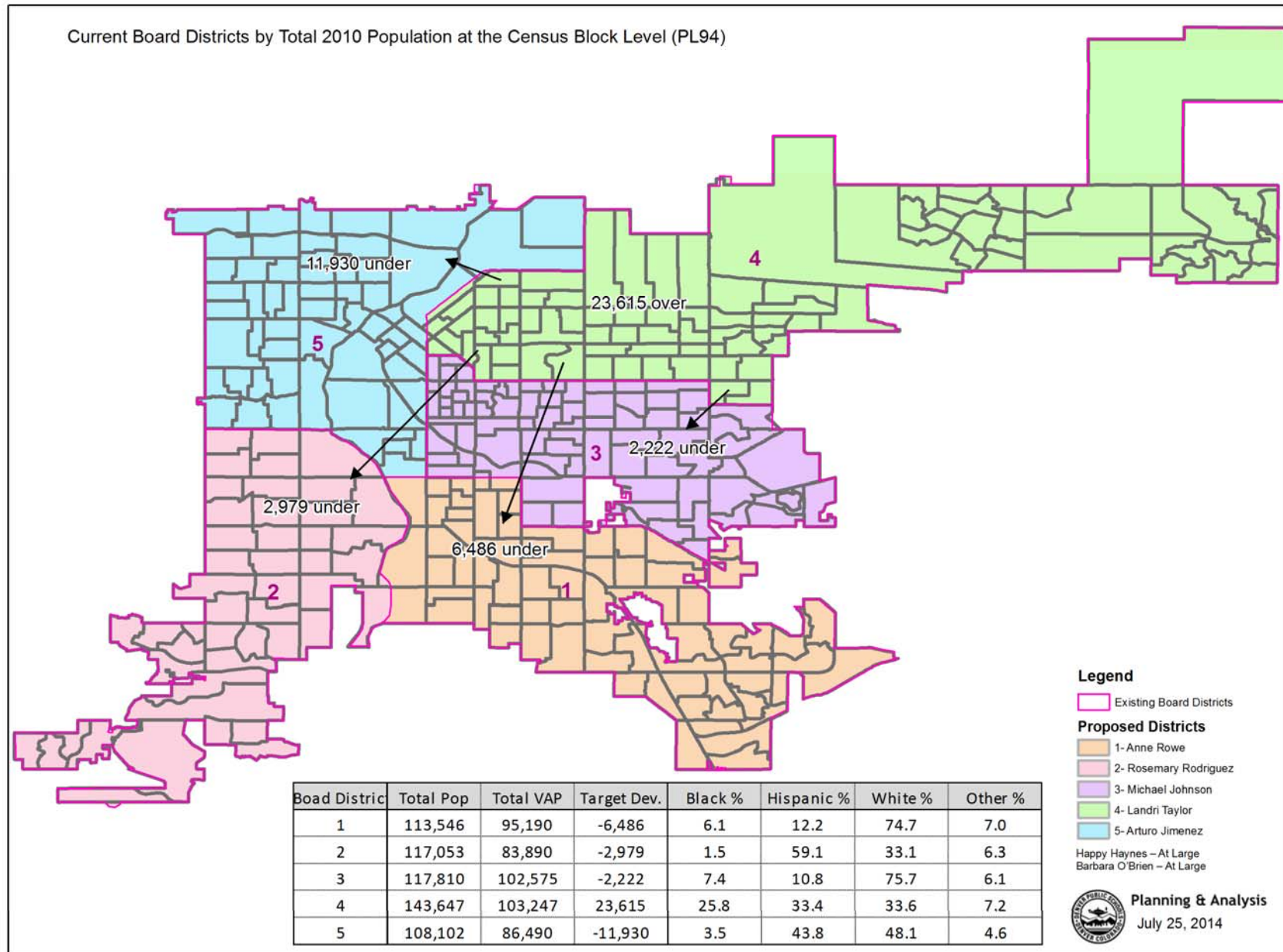

Context Setting: Current Board Districts with 2010 Total Population

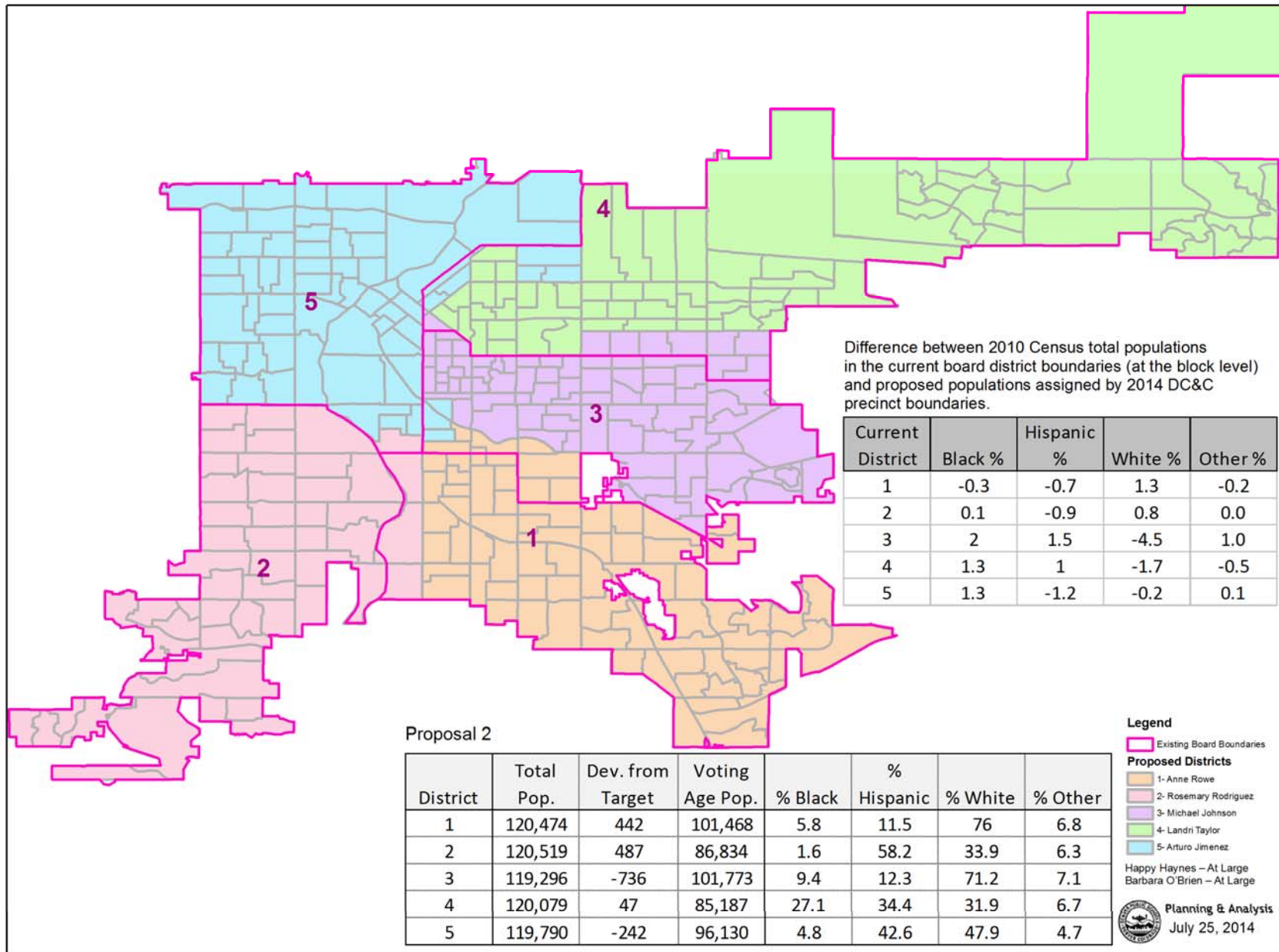


Guiding Principles for the Redistricting Process

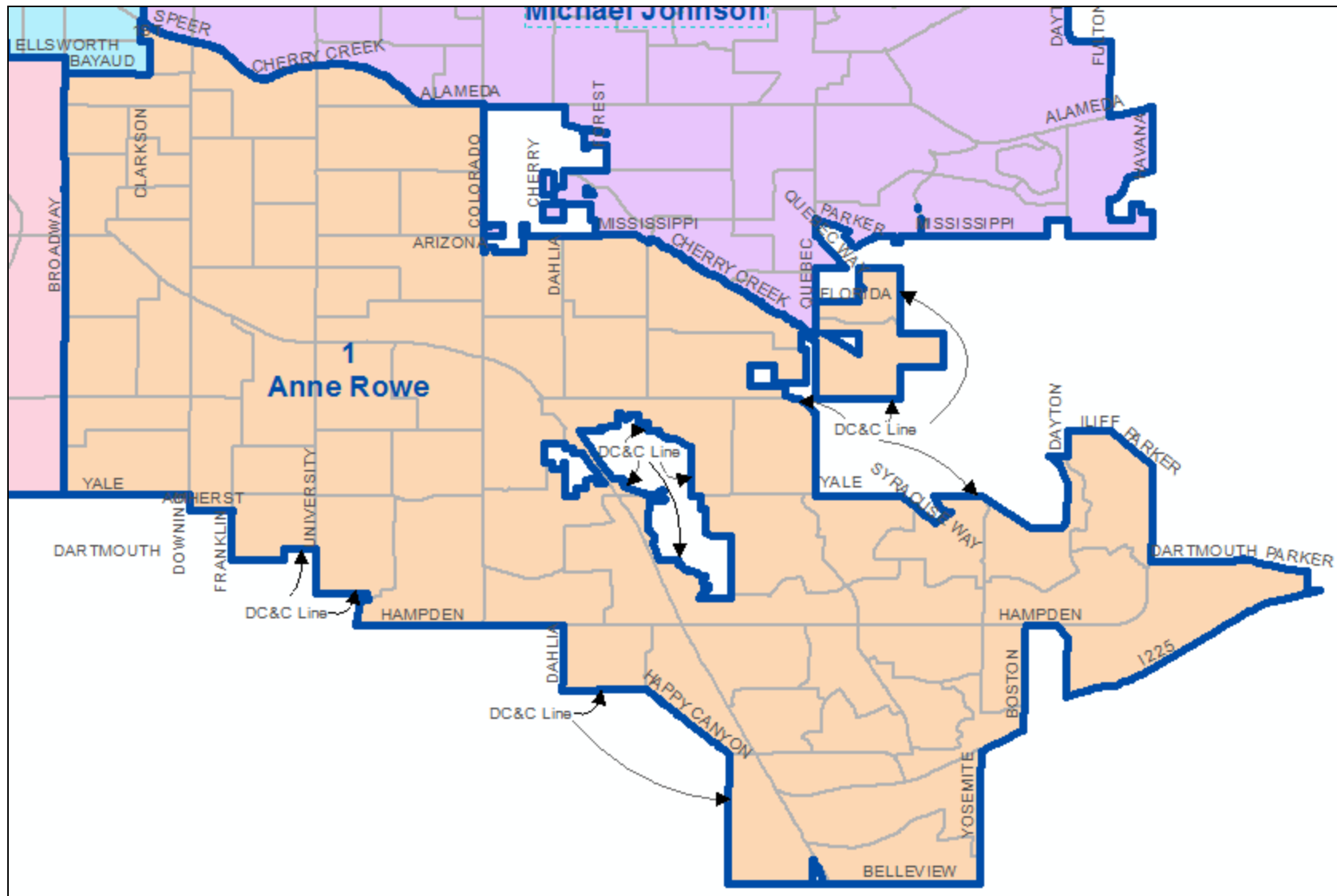
- Balance total population (representation, one person one vote)
- Maintain minimal impact on racial/ethnic concentrations (voting rights act, equal protection clause, avoid dilution of minority vote)
- Align with City precincts (whole precincts, functionality, contiguous election precincts)
- Incorporate natural boundaries (preservation of communities of interest, compact districts)
- Minimize the number of impacted families as a result of this process

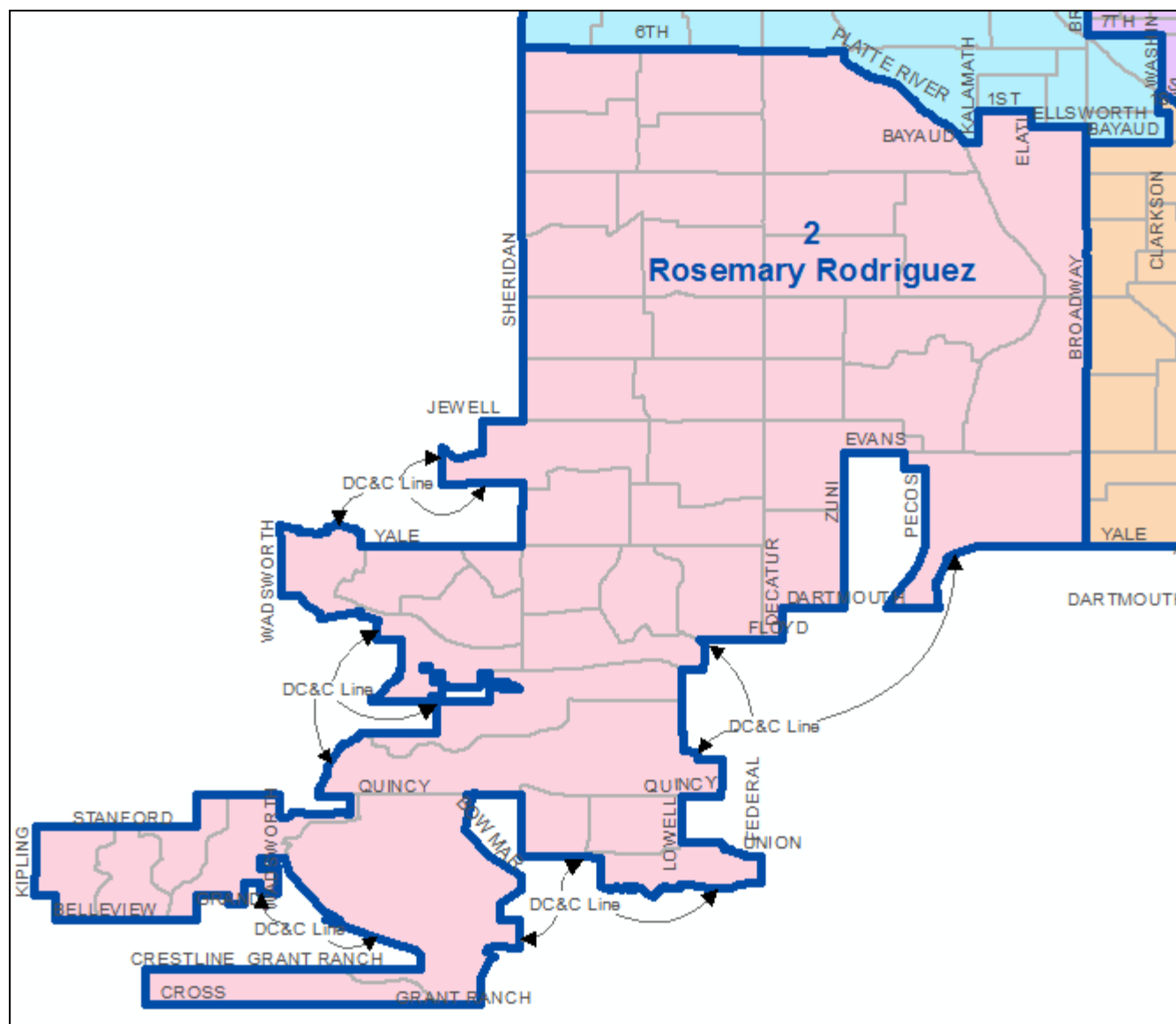

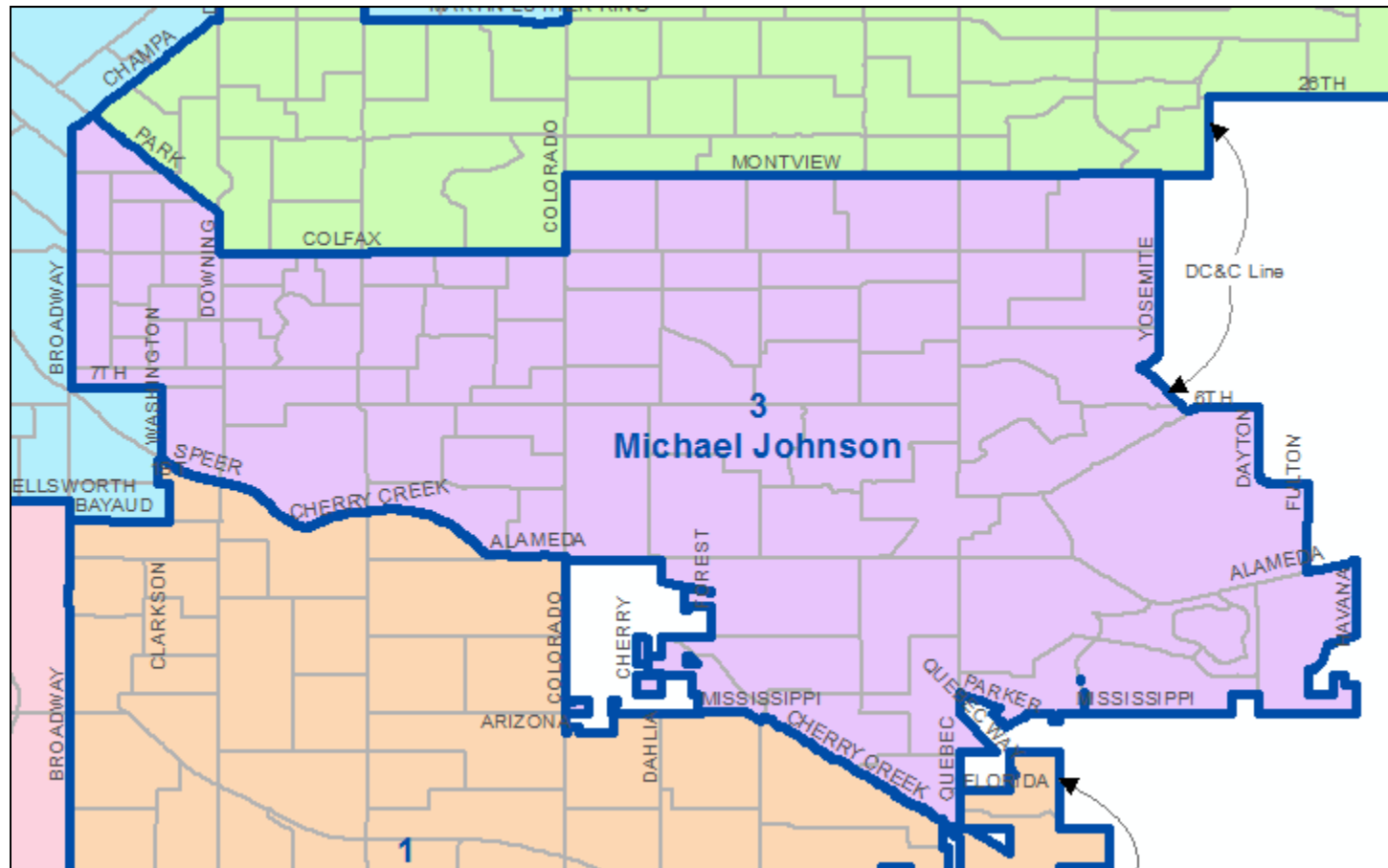
Draft Proposal for Redistricting: District 1



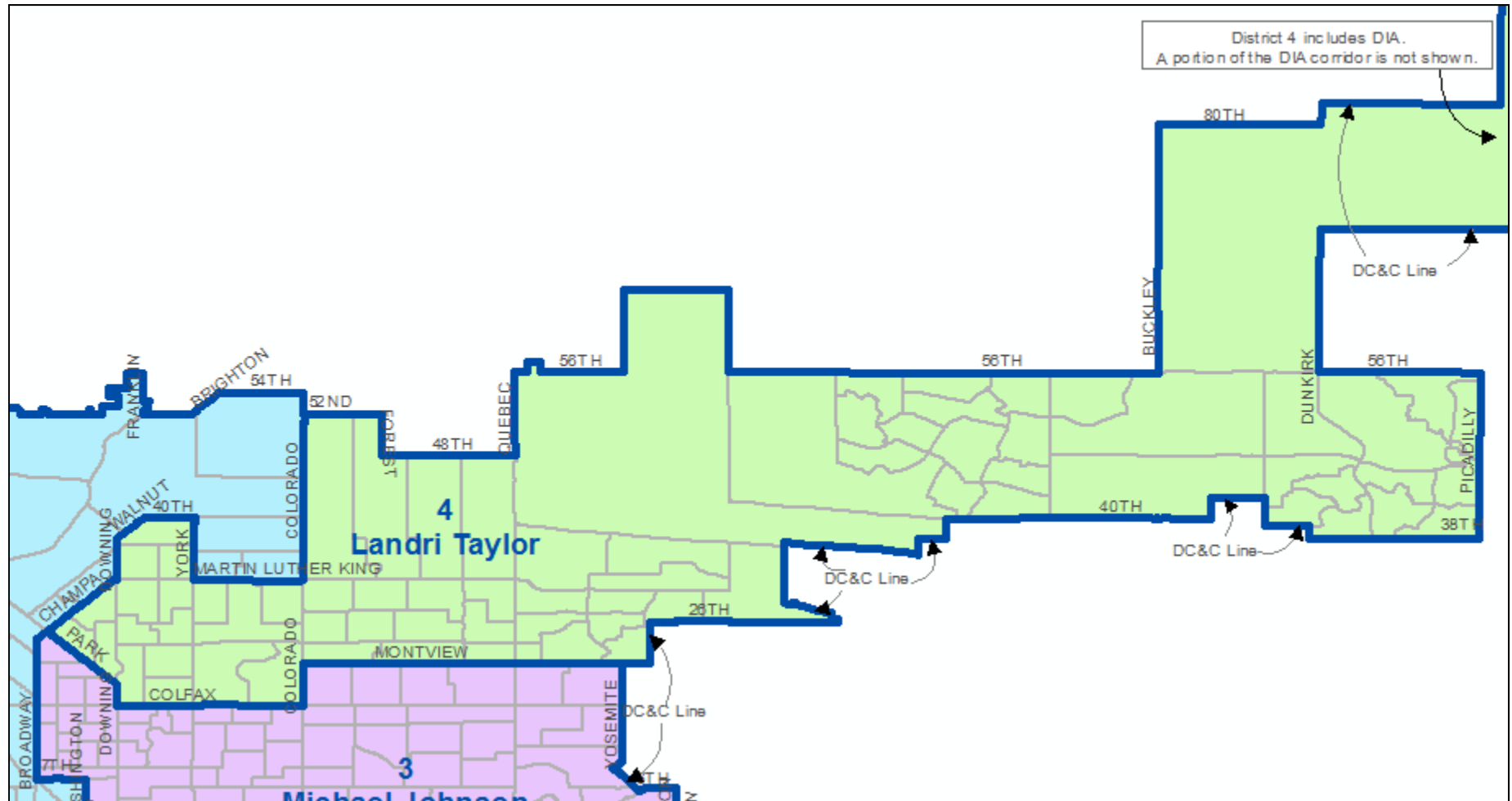

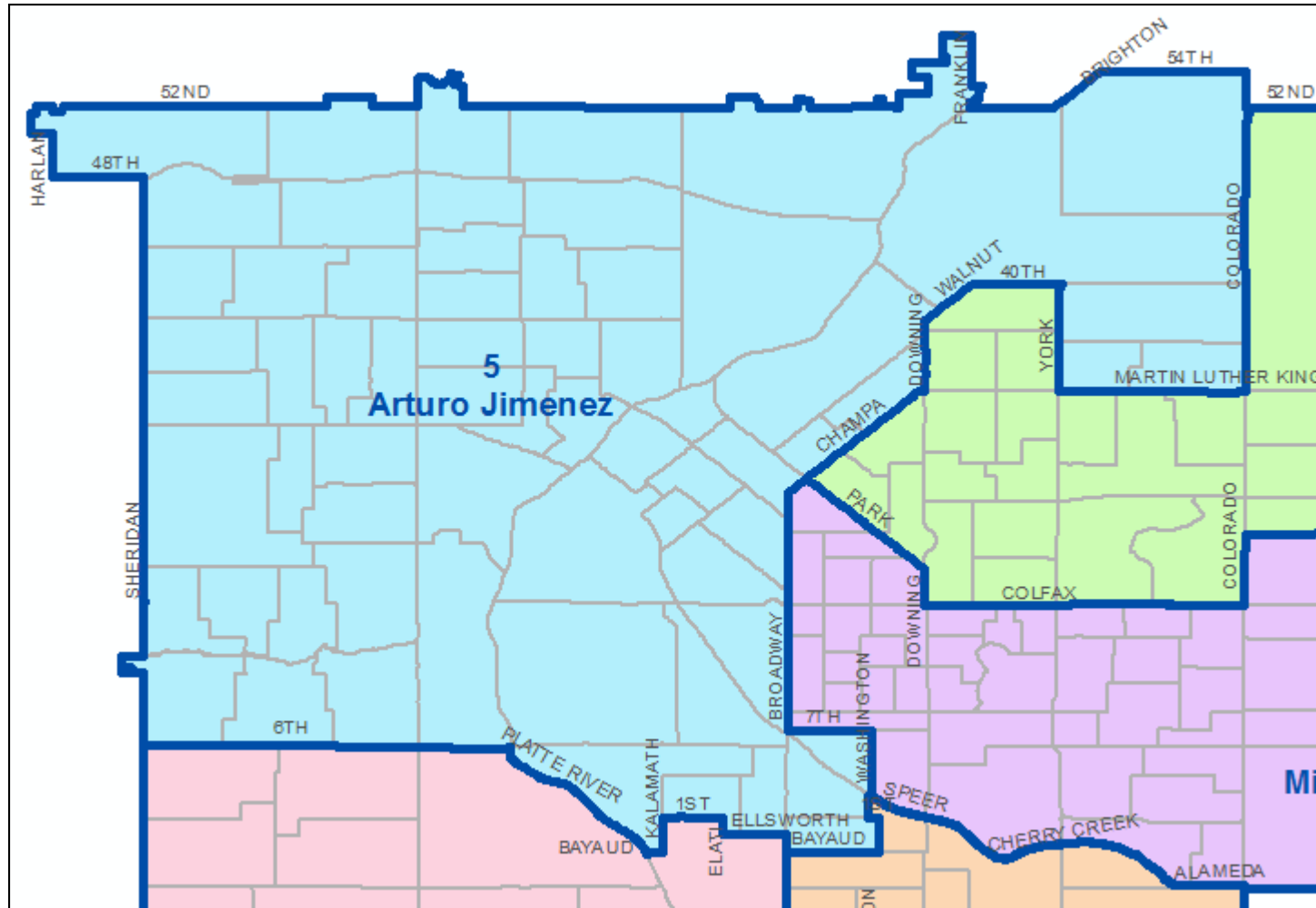

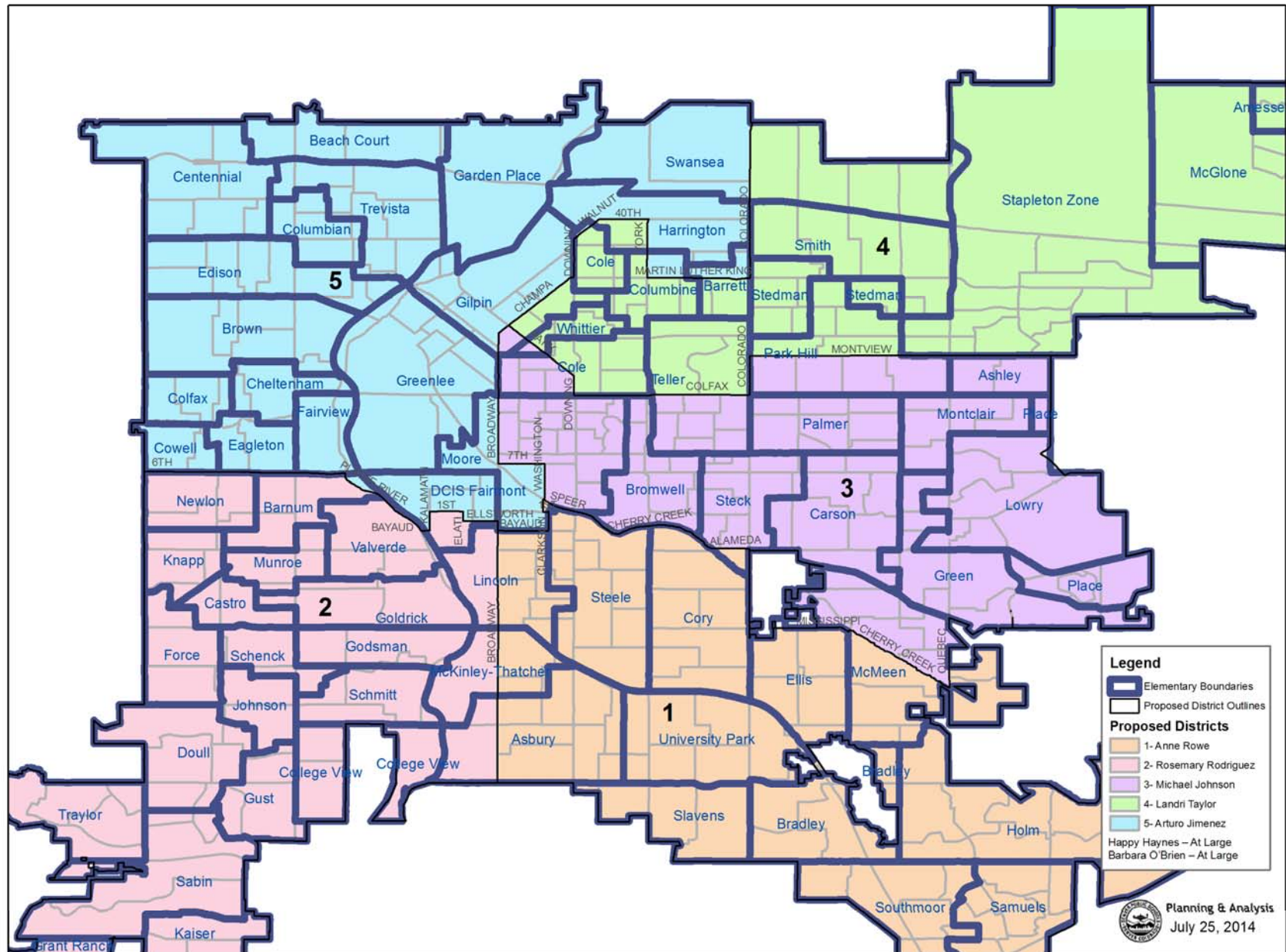

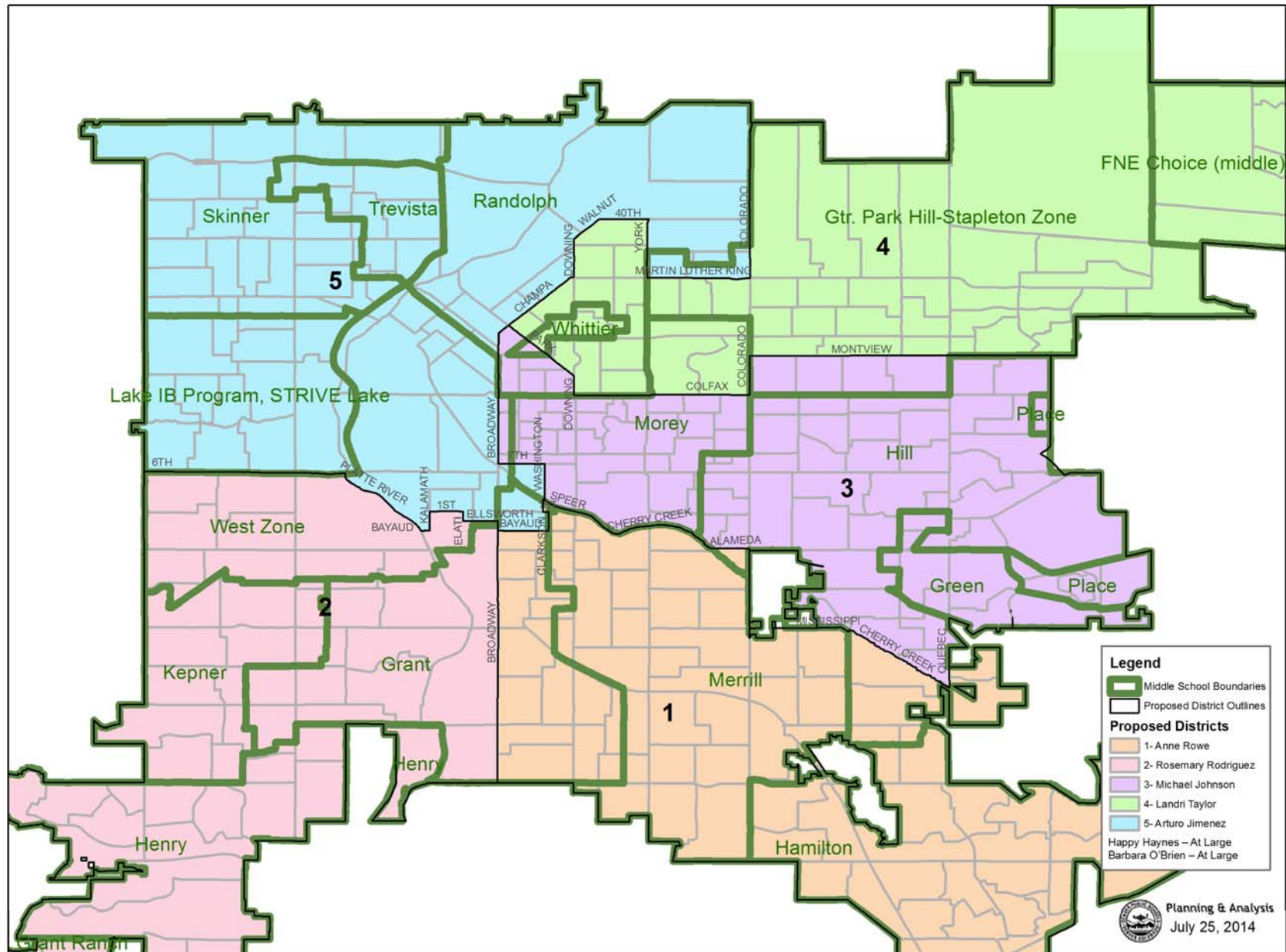
Alignment of Draft Proposal to Guiding Principles

Principle	Consideration	Proposal Alignment
Balance total population (representation, one person one vote)	With 600,158 residents, goal is to have districts as close to 120,000 each as possible	All districts are within 0.6% of the goal
Minimize the impact on racial/ethnic concentrations within districts	Using the previous districts as a base to maintain as close as possible the racial	The largest dilution of the vote of any traditionally underrepresented group is a loss of 1.2% of Hispanic population in District 2, which does not change the Hispanic majority in that District.
Align with City precincts	Utilize the 2014 city precincts	100% of precincts are aligned
Incorporate natural boundaries	Use natural features as boundaries between districts	Broadway divides Districts 1 & 2. 6 th Avenue divides Districts 2 & 5. Speer / Cherry Creek Drive divides Districts 1 & 3. Park Ave, Colfax and Montview divides Districts 3 & 4.
Minimize the number of impacted families	Maintain the existing districts as much as possible	Roughly 93% of families will not have their district changed as a result of this proposal

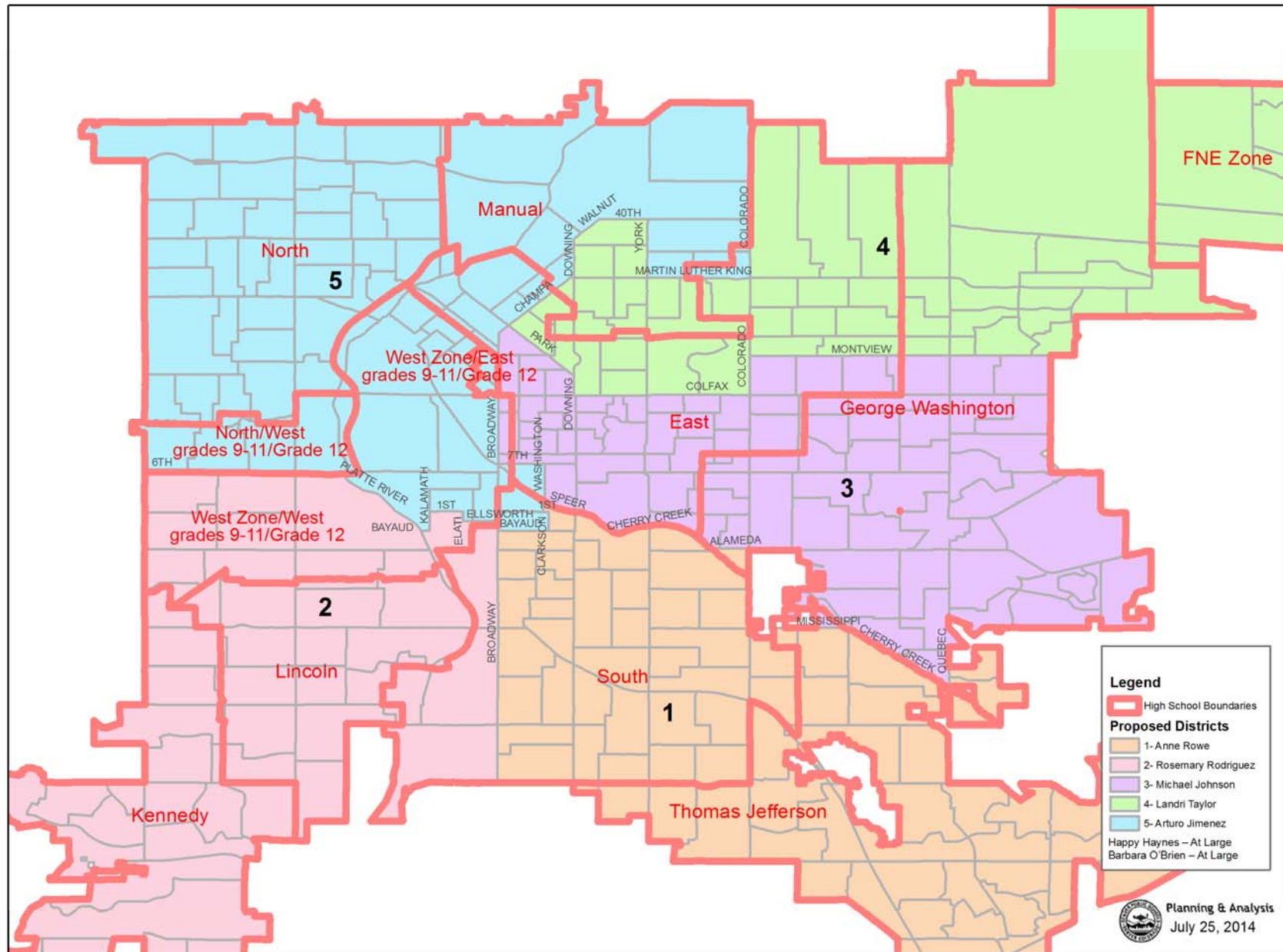
Draft Proposal for Redistricting: Elementary School Boundary Overlay

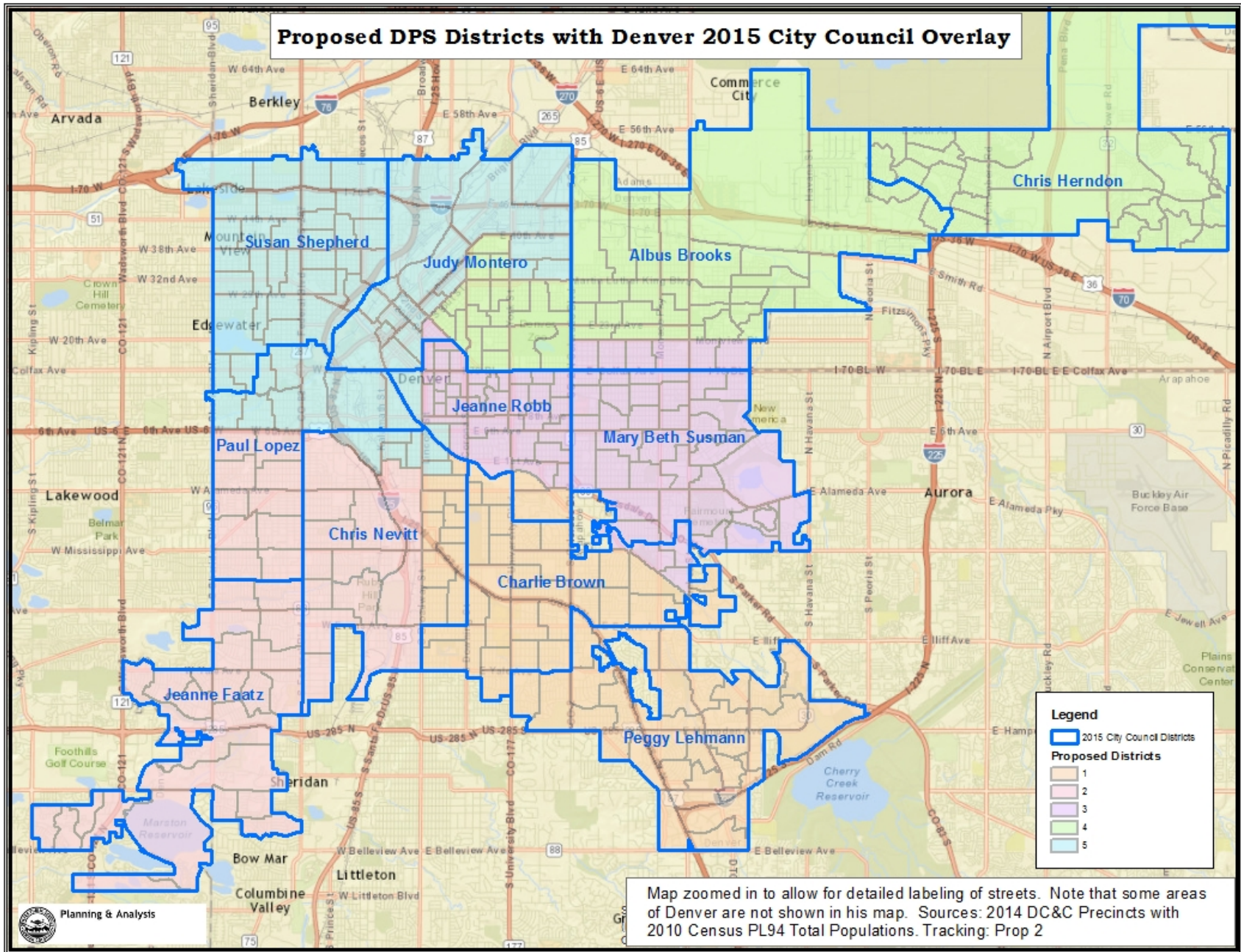


Draft Proposal for Redistricting: Middle School Boundary Overlay

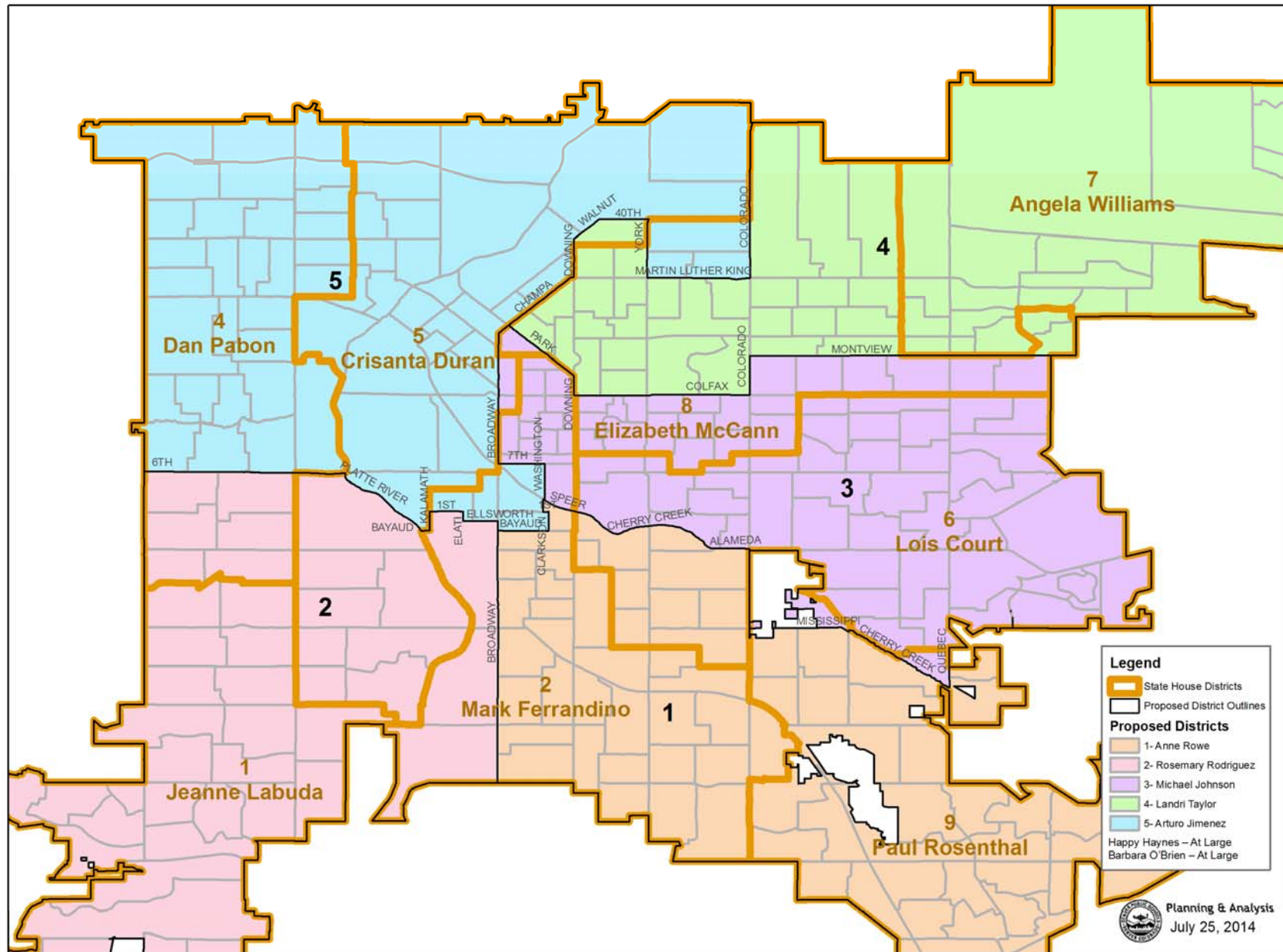


Draft Proposal for Redistricting: High School Boundary Overlay
